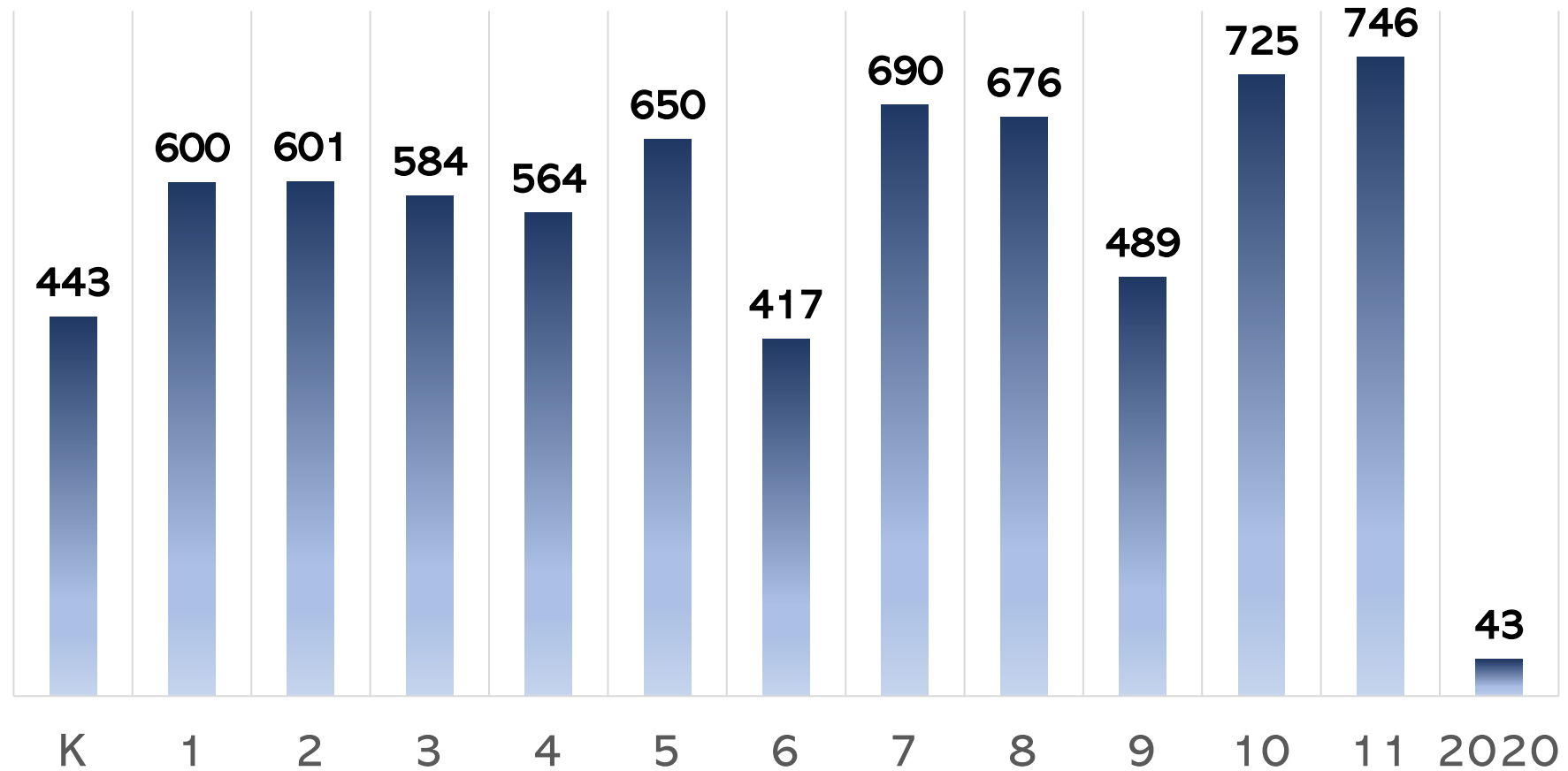

 - *Results are within a confidence interval of 99%, +/- 1.2%*

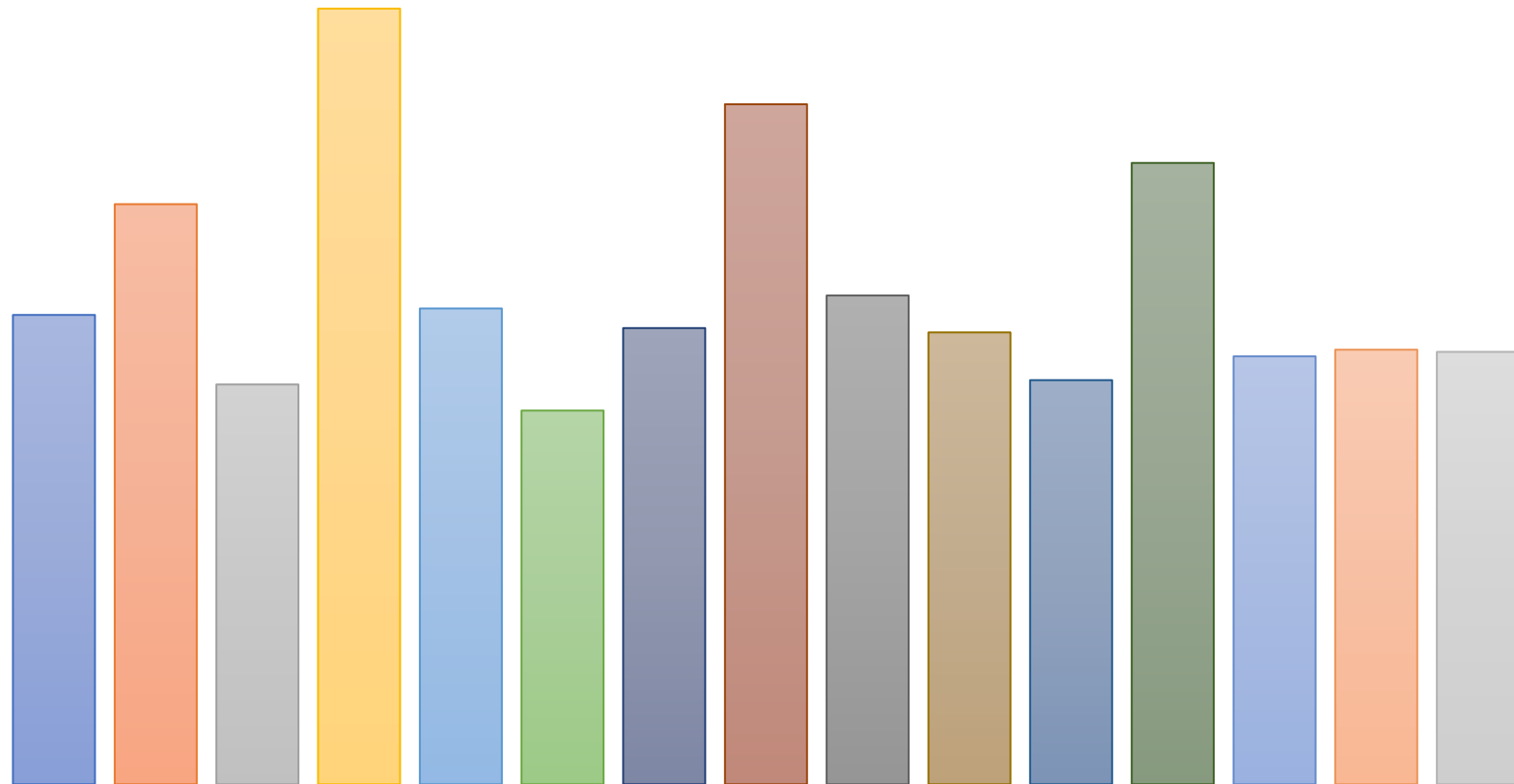


Grade Level Distribution



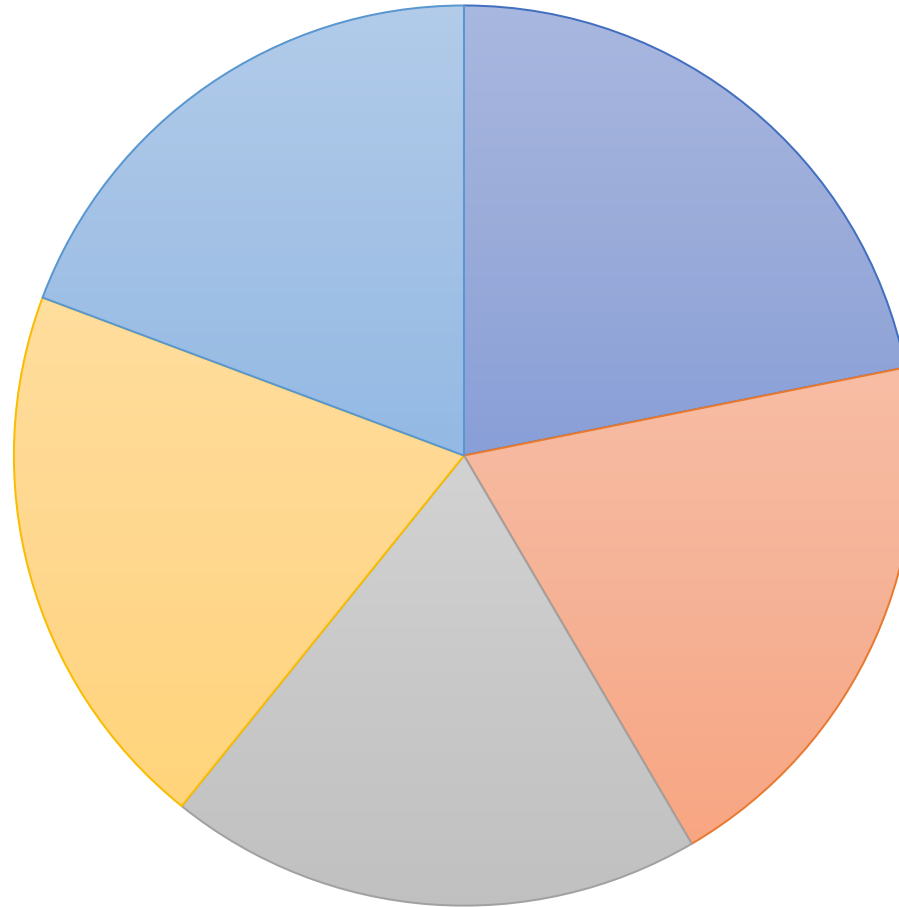

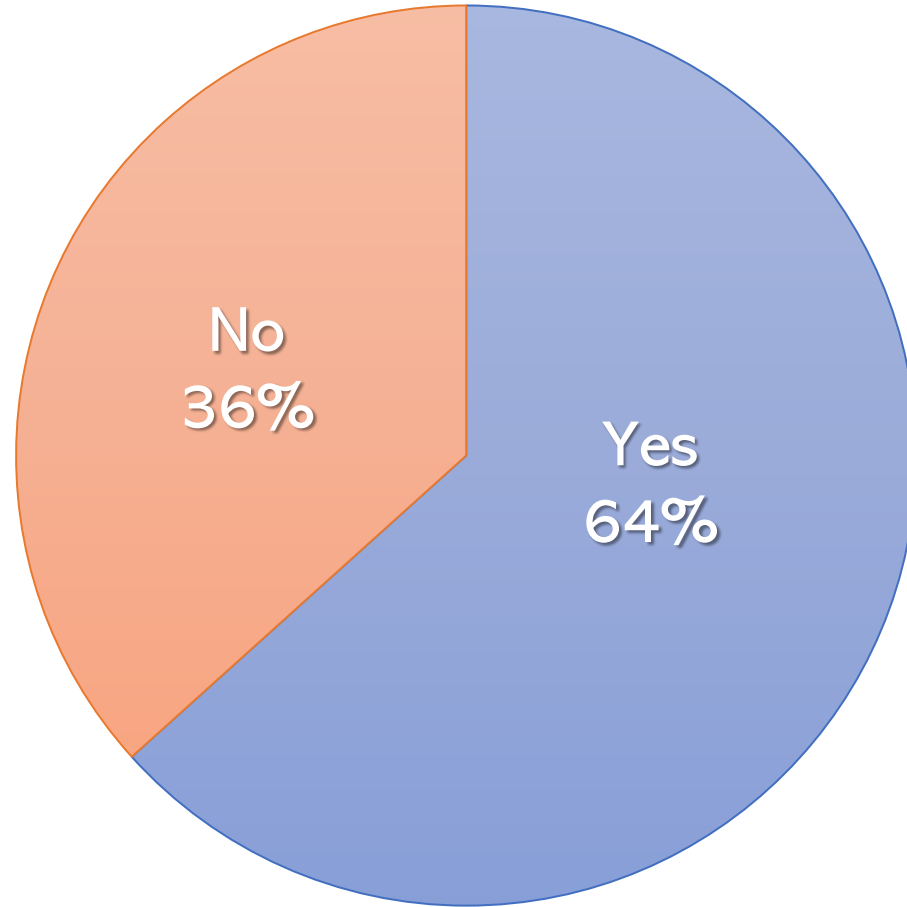


Please select your top three priorities regarding health safety practices if schools were to open for in-person classes in the fall.

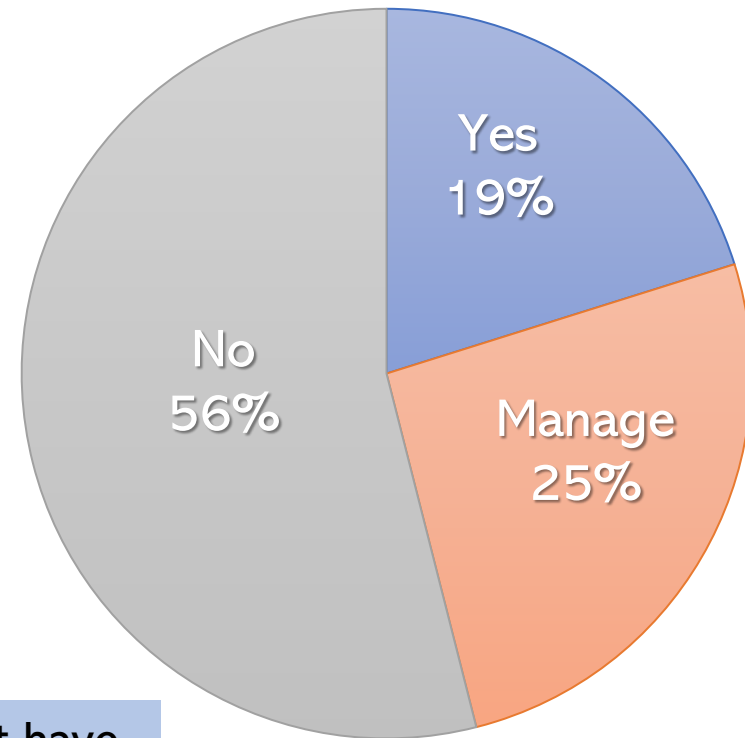
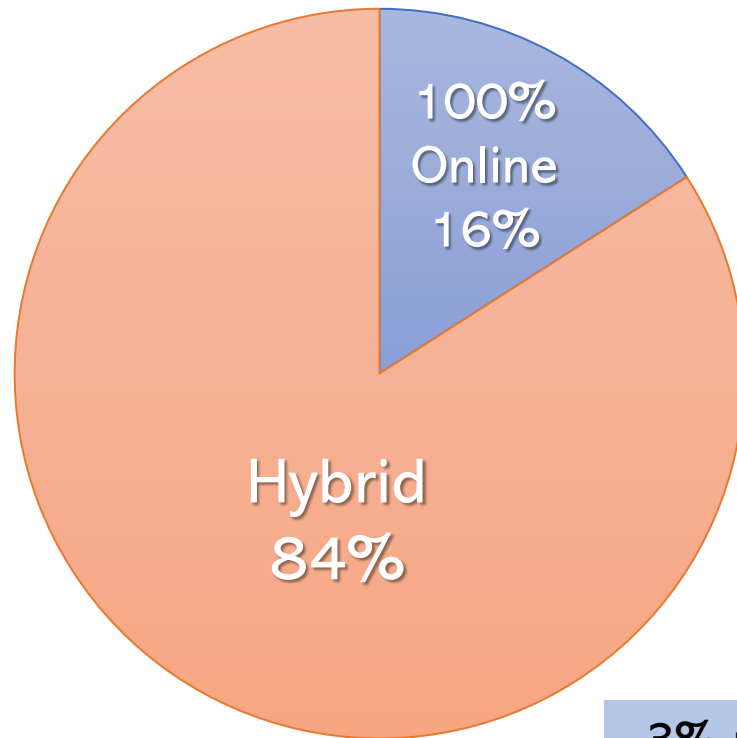


Comfortable with child wearing a mask while in school?



We are looking forward to returning to school in a traditional in-person format; however, if this is not possible, which of the following delivery models would you most support for your student this fall?

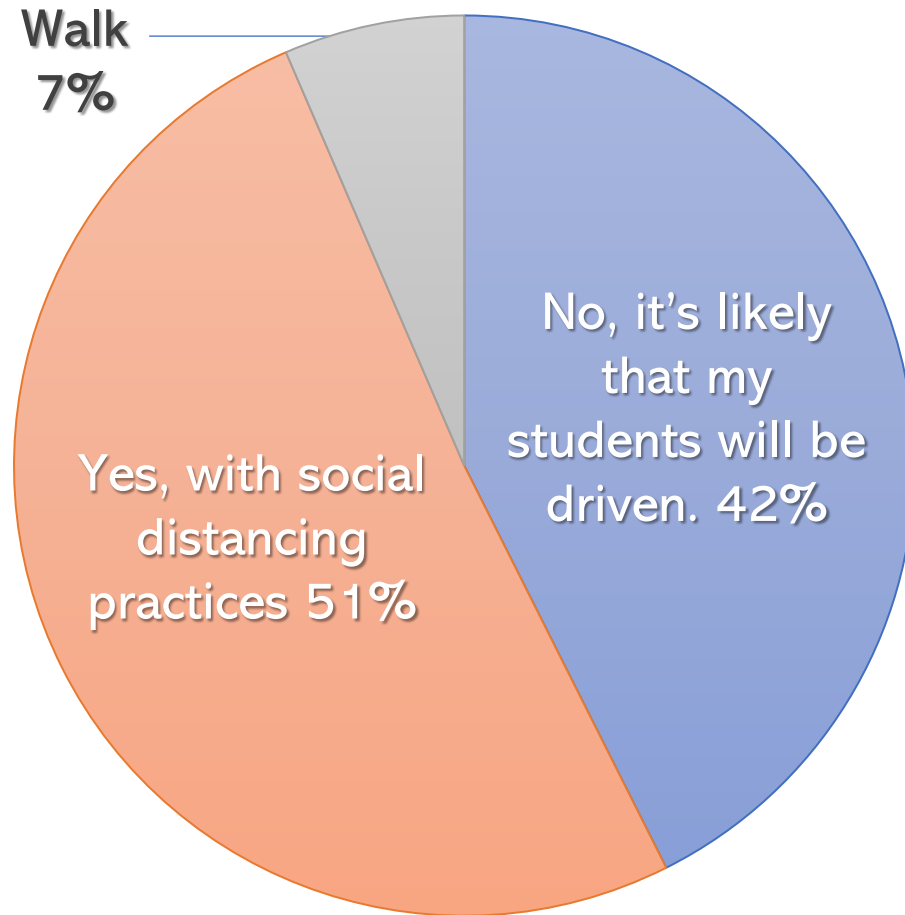
Will childcare be an issue for your family for the Online and Hybrid models outlined in the previous question?



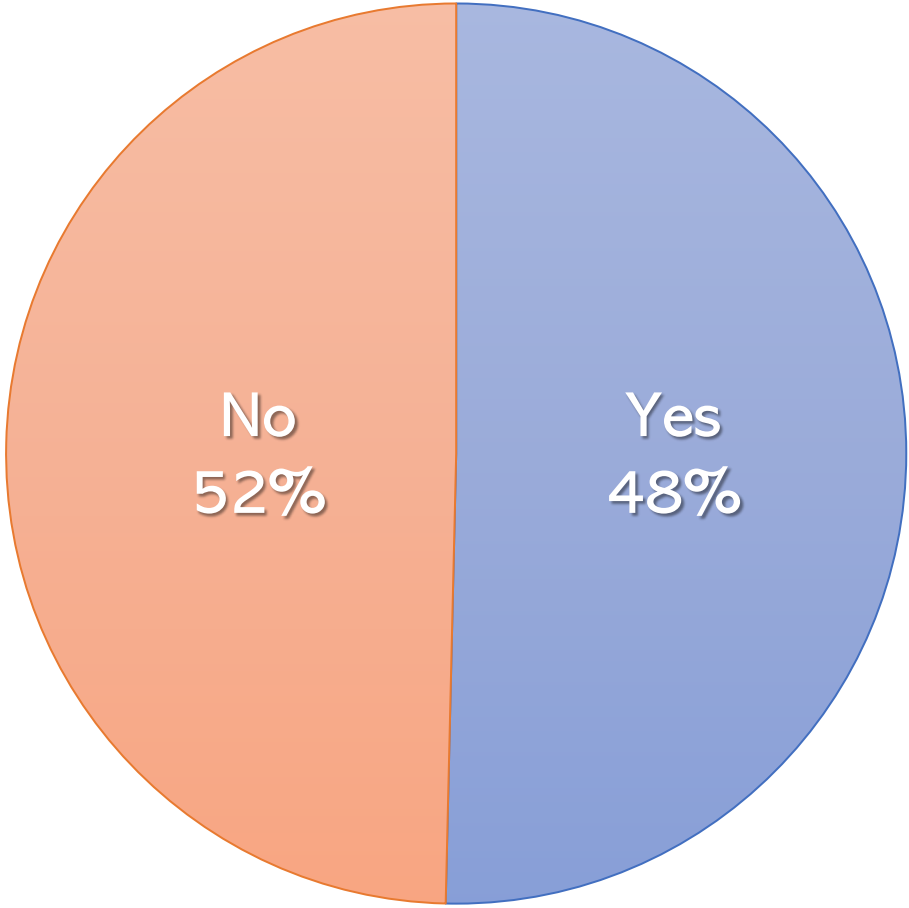
3% report that they do not have adequate access to internet service to support online learning.



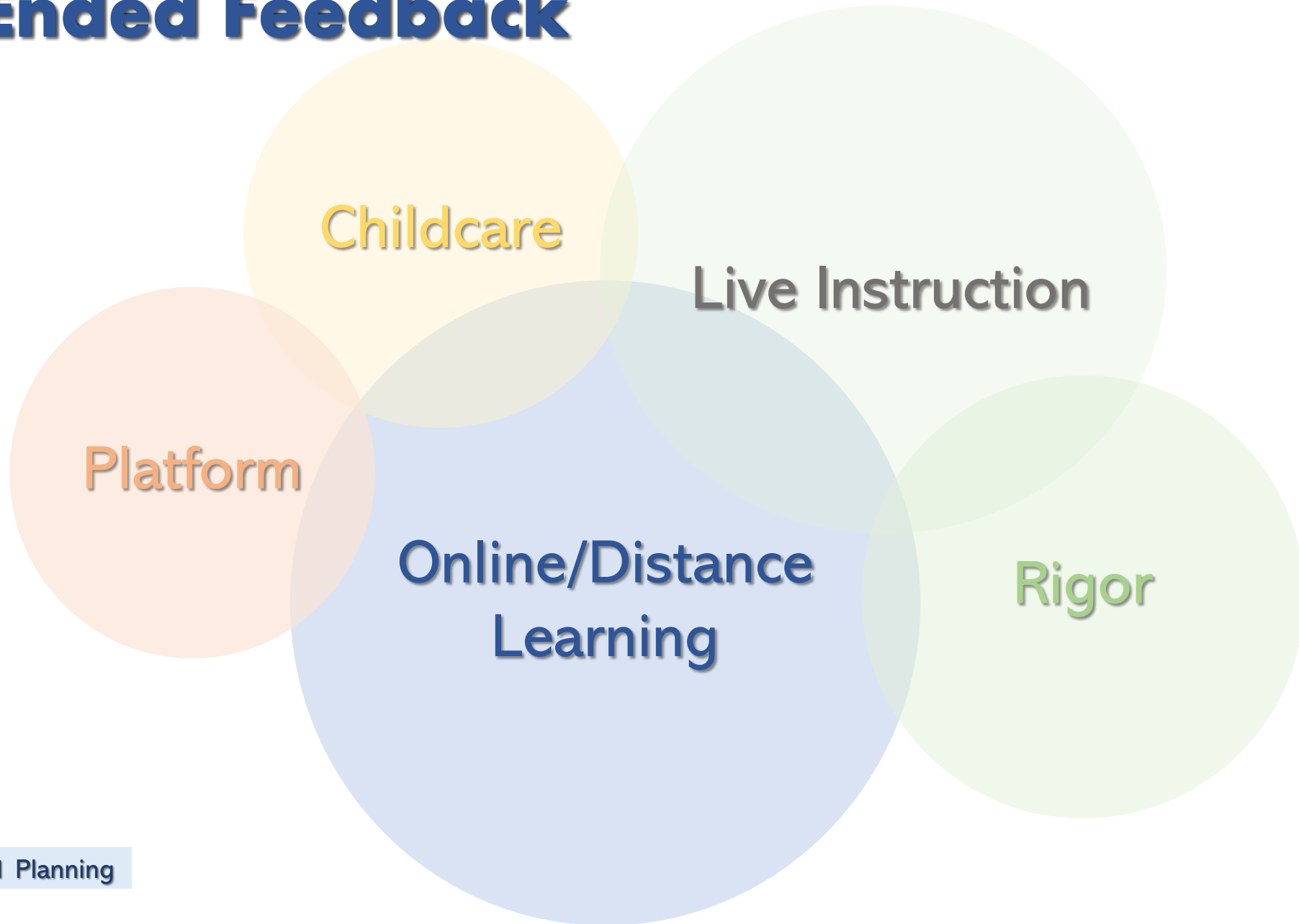
Will you use district transportation?



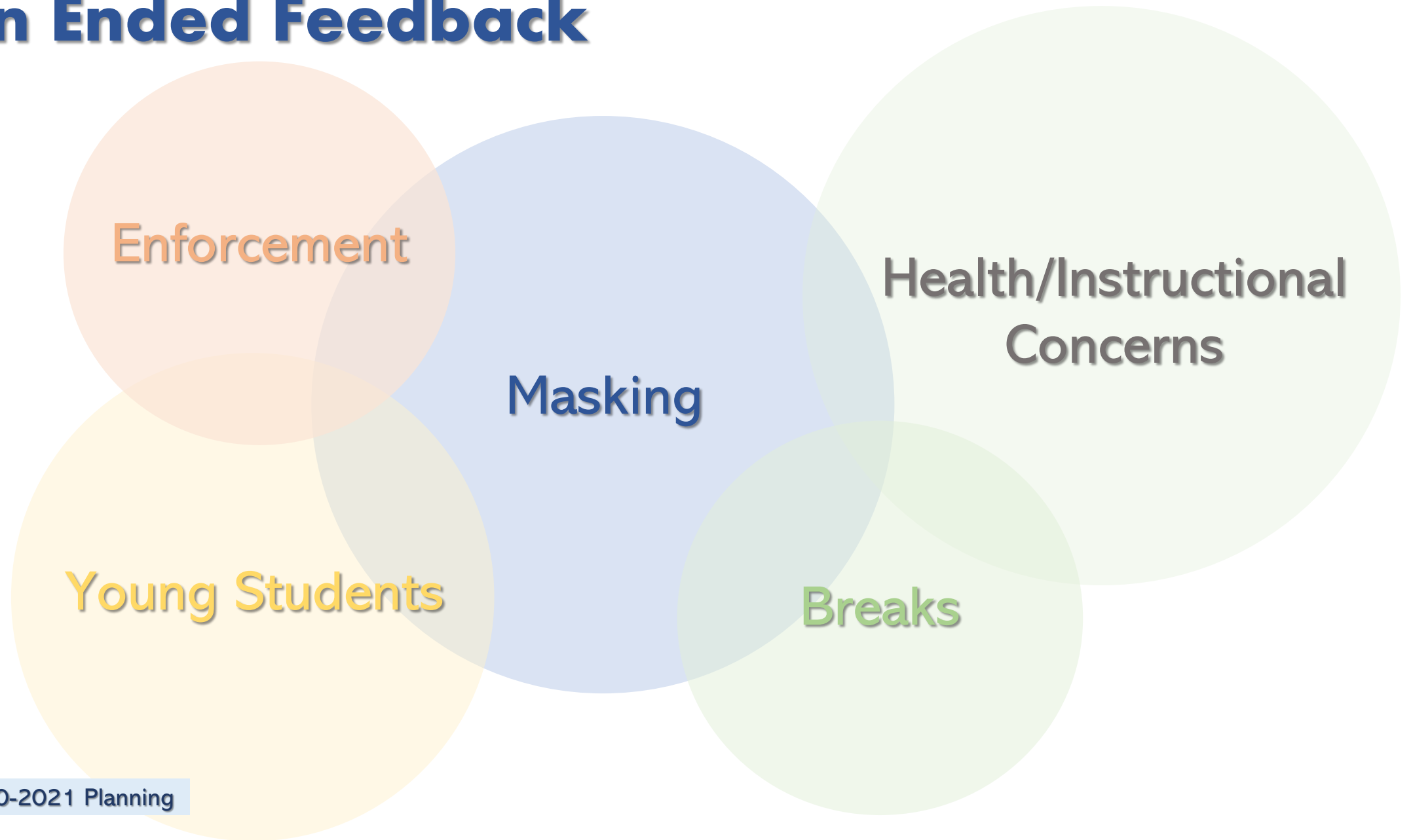
Would you support starting 2 weeks earlier?



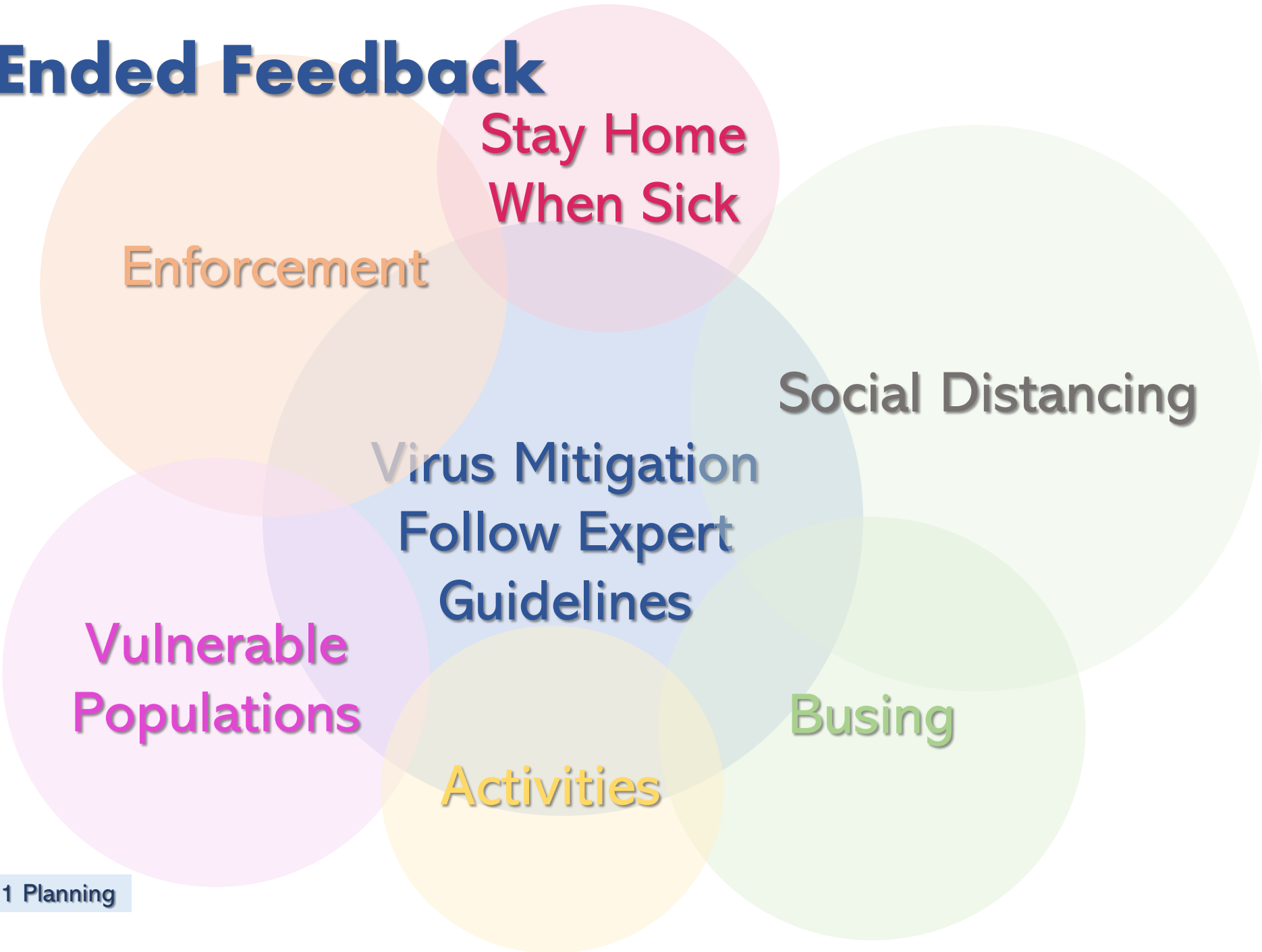

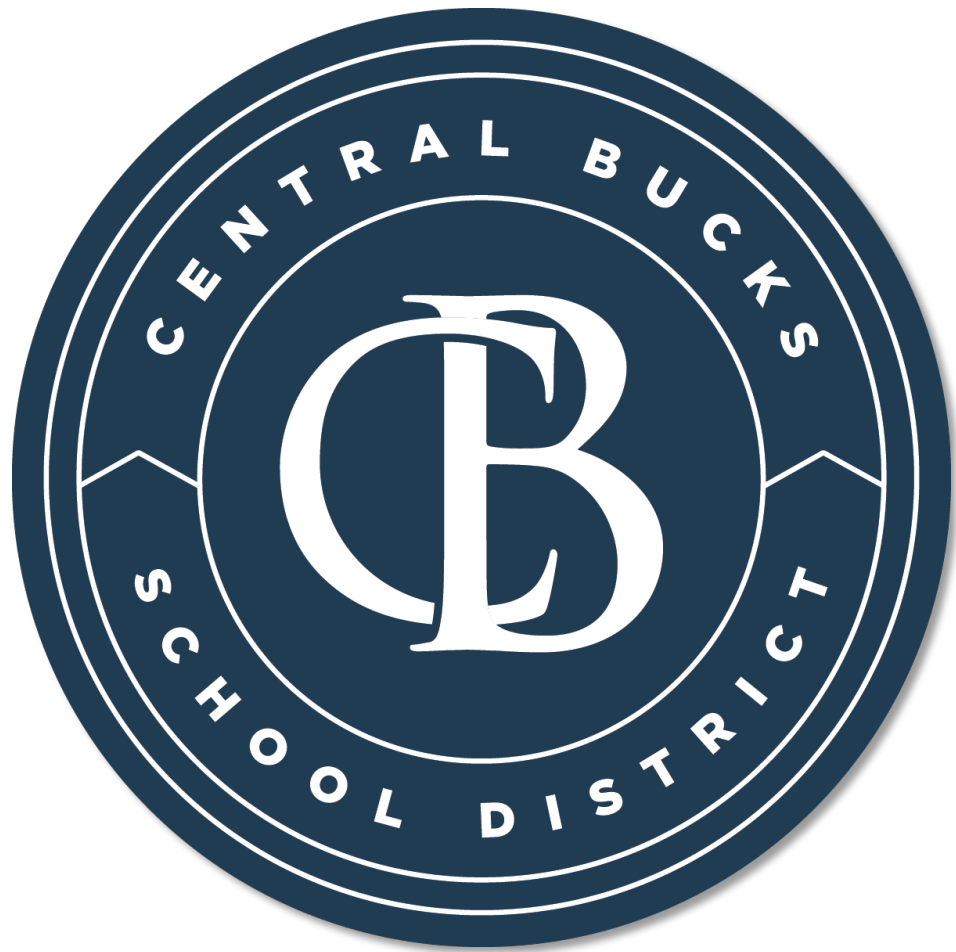
